Dear Colleagues,

Parasitic infections are major health problem in India and other tropical countries. These parasites not only cause high morbidity and mortality in humans but cause several diseases in animals, including pet animals, food animals and livestock. Most of these parasites are water and food borne, but soil transmitted and vector borne parasitoses are also very common. Some parasitic diseases such as malaria and helminthic infestations are major cause of mortality and morbidity, respectively. In animal both endoparasites and ectoparasites are equally important and some of these can cause zoonotic diseases in humans. However, After AIDS epidemic, several parasites have attained more significance in humans than ever before. This has also changed the epidemiology of parasitic infections. Therefore, specific and timely diagnosis of such parasitic diseases has become of paramount importance.

In view of these developments, Indian Academy of Tropical Parasitology (IATP) has kindly invited the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi to organize second annual conference after the success of first Tropacon in Chennai in 2007. I have accepted the invitation of Prof. SC Parija, the Founder President of IATP to shoulder this great responsibility.
