Report on patients admitted in Medicine Unit II with exposure to radioactive material


The following patients are receiving treatment in C-6/C2 Ward since the evening of 9. 4. 2010 with history of exposure to radioactive material.

Shri Rajender who was getting treatment in C2-ICU developed hypotension, a manifestation of multi-organ failure, and did not respond to all possible interventions. He had a cardiac arrest at 8.30PM on 26.4.2010 and despite all measures of resuscitation passed away at 9.30 PM. As it was a medico-legal case his body has been handed over to police.

All other four patients have low TLC and low platelet count. All of them are receiving supportive treatment. The need for bone marrow transplantation is being explored in all of them.
