- 1.1 252 posts of Assistant Professors in various disciplines for Centres/Departments were advertised vide Advt. No. AIIMS/New Delhi/Fac.Rect/2021/1 with due reservation as per reservation roster as well as backlog vacancies belonging to SC/ST/OBC & PWBD were advertised (Annexure-I). Against this advertisement, total 2662 candidates had applied online.
- 1.2 Out of 252 advertised posts:
 - 14 posts in the following disciplines were withdrawn/put up on hold due to the reasons given against each:

- 1.3 The details of remaining 230 posts[for which interview were held] with reservation status, no. of online applicants, total Hard copy received and candidates shortlisted & recommended to be called for interview are enclosed at Annexure II:-
 - 4% reservation for PWBD was also provided in the aforesaid posts as per rosters point with backlog vacancies.
- 1.4. All applications were screened at two level;
 - i) Screening Committee at the level of concerned department.
 - ii) Main Screening Committee under Director, AIIMS.

Eligible candidates, conforming to Recruitment Rules were shortlisted to be called for interview by Standing Selection Committee. Total 1688 candidates for 91 disciplines (230 posts) were shortlisted to be called for interview.

1.4 The meetings of the Standing Selection Committees were held in different phases to interview the above mentioned candidates as per details given below:

Out of total 102 candidates who appeared for promotion under APS scheme:

- 02 Additional Professor for promotion to the post of Professor were found 'UNFIT' due to the following reasons and:

1. Dr. Asmita Patil(Sl.No.59) -

Committee observed that her research output in terms of publications and number of grants during the assessment period were unsatisfactory. For example, publication (Pub-Med.) within the assessment period as the first or corresponding author were only **Two**; and extramural grant as PI was nil. She could not satisfactorily answer the questions posed by the experts. The Selection Committee along with the experts unanimously decided to declare her "UNFIT" for promotion to the post of Professor of Physiology.

2. Dr. Maroof Ahmad Khan (Sl. No. 73):-

Committee observed that his research output in terms of publications and number of grants during the assessment period were unsatisfactory. For example, publication within the assessment period as the first or corresponding author were only **two**; and extramural grant as PI was only **One**. He could not satisfactorily answer the questions posed by the experts. The Selection Committee along with the experts unanimously decided to declare him "UNFIT" for promotion to the post of Professor of Biostatistics.

 Recommendations of 01 Additional Professor for promotion to the post of Professor kept in Sealed Cover:

Dr. Anoop Kumar Daga(Sl.No.53)

The recommendations of the Standing Selection Committee in respect of Dr. Anoop Kumar Daga, Additional Professor for promotion to the grade of Professor was kept in a sealed cover as disciplinary proceedings under Rule 14 of the CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 is pending against him. The recommendations of the Standing Selection Committee may only be taken into consideration after conclusion of said disciplinary proceedings and outcome of the same, as per laid down instructions on the subject.

Due to disciplinary proceedings, promotion order of 01 Associate Professor to Additional Professor kept in abeyance till completion of penalty.

Dr. Partha Haldar(Sl.No.2 of batch w.e.f.01.07.2021)

Dr. Partha Haldar, Associate Professor of Community Medicine, appeared before the Standing Selection Committee Meeting in the year 2021 for promotion to next grade of Additional Professor w.e.f. 1.72020 and the recommendations of the Committee was kept under a sealed cover as disciplinary proceedings under Rule 14 of the CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 were pending against him. Subsequently, a major penalty was imposed upon him and sealed cover recommendations were not acted upon as per extant guidelines/instructions on the subject.

Now, his candidature has been considered by the Standing Selection Committee on 10.09.2022 for promotion to the grade of Additional Professor of Community Medicine under Assessment Promotion Scheme (APS) for the batch 01.07.2021. Penalty of "Reduction to a lower stage in time scale of pay of the post of Associate Professor for a period of one year in the time scale of pay i.e. Level-13A-1+, with further directions that the said Dr. ParthaHaldar, Associate Professor of Community Medicine, AIIMS, New Delhi will not earn increment of pay during the period of such reduction and on the expiry of such period, the reduction will not have the effect of postponing the future increments of his pay, after imposition of penalty" was imposed

on him vide order dated 18.4.2022 and his currency of penalty period is up to 17.04.2023. He was recommended FIT by the Standing Selection Committee for promotion to the next grade of Additional Professor for the batch 1.7.2021 and the recommended his promotion to the grade of Additional Professor of Community Medicine under APS after completion of penalty imposed upon him i.e. from 18.04.2023.

2.4 In this connection, it is pertinent to mention here that Governing Body in its meeting held on 10.10.2017 under agenda item No.GB-155/6 desired that AIIMS, New Delhi should put in place a mechanism(HR Module) with the approval of President, AIIMS to approve the appointment of the candidates selected by the Standing Selection Committee, so that such candidates could join their post without waiting for the meeting of the Governing Body and ex-post-facto approval of Governing Body should be obtained subsequently.

Accordingly, President, AIIMS, had constituted a HR Sub-Committee, consisting of following members, for this purpose:

2.5. The Recommendations of the Standing election Committee which were kept in sealed cover, were placed before the HR Sub-Committee on 19.11.2022 in the Office of Secretary (Health), Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India and Chairperson of the HR Committee. HR Sub Committee perused the recommendation and approved the same.

These were put to President, AIIMS for approval. After getting the approval of the President, AIIMS, appointment letters were issued to 183 selected candidates under Direct Recruitment for the post of Assistant Professor in various disciplines and promotion letter were issued to 98 existing Faculty members of AIIMS, New Delhi under Assessment Promotion Scheme on 28.11.2022.

IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW ASSESSMENT PROMOTION SCHEME FOR THE FACULTY OF AHMS - GUIDELINES AS APPROVED BYTHE GOVERNING BODY ON 25.04.1992 AND 5TH MARCH, 2001.

The Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare vide their D.C. letter No.V.16020/35/89-ME(PG) dated the 24th December, 1991 conveyed their approval for implementation of the revised Assessment Promotion Scheme for the faculty members of AllMS. While conveying the revision of scales of pay of the faculty members of AllMS, New Delhi/PGL Chandigarh, Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare vide letter No.V.16020/41/97-ME(PG) (Vol.II) dated the 10th March, 2000, has also conveyed their approval for extension of Assessment Promotion Scheme from Additional Professors to Professors w.e.f. 01.07.2000, Further, the Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare vide their letter No. V.16020/57/2008-ME-I dated the 12th January, 2011 and No.V.16020/11/2009-ME-I dated the 30th March, 2011 conveyed the revised Promotion Scheme which shall be effective from 01.07.2008 notionally subject to condition that pay fixation and other financial benefits shall be from 31.12.2008. The salient features of the Assessment Promotion Scheme are as under:-

- i) Assistant Professors with three years of service will be eligible for appointment to the post of Associate Professor subject to clearance of the prescribed selection process.
- ii) Associate Professors with three years of service will be eligible for appointment to the post of Additional Professor subject to clearance of the prescribed selection process
- iii) Additional Professors with four years of service will be eligible for appointment to the post of Professor subject to clearance of the prescribed y selection process.

2. APPLICATION

These Guidelines will apply to promotions to the faculty posts in the grades of the Associate Professor, Additional Professor and Professor.

ELIGIBILITY

Assistant Professors & Associate Professors with 3 years and Additional Professors with 4 years of regular service in the respective grades in AIIMS are eligible for Promotion as Associate Professor, Additional Professor and Professor respectively. No other conditions, e.g. higher qualifications as for direct recruits, need be fulfilled.

4. PERIODICITY AND CRUCIAL DATE 435

The Assessment Board will meet once a year and considered the fitness of all persons who have completed the requisite eligibility service as on 30th June of that year. All promotions under the Scheme will be effective from 1st July.

6 SENIORITY LIST

As per the rules in force, there can be direct recruitment to all grades of the faculty and selection on each occasion could be for appointment to be made at the same time but in more than one discipline. The coinbined semiority list of the Institute shall be worked out as follows:

- i). The seniority of employees of the Institute in each category shall be determined by the order of merit in which they were selected for appointment to the grade in question, those selected on an earlier occasion being ranked senior as a block to those selected later (Regulation 26 of AIIMS Regulations, 1958).
- ii) The preparation of a seniority list of persons selected in the same selection committee would involve the following steps:-

STEP-I

Draw up list of persons on the basis of their date of joining those joining on an earlier date being placed above those joining on a later, dule.

STEP-II

In the list prepared as above, those who join on the same date may be arranged in order of age—those born earlier being placed above those born later.

STEP-III

For those joining on the same date and adjusted as in step II above according to their age, further re-arrangement may be carried out so that the original inter-seniority of the Institute employees in the Lower Post/Grade maintained. This operation may be done by pulling down the junior in the previous combined seniority list immediately below his senior in that list now appearing in this list even though he may be elder in age.

The above list may now be further modified to carry corrections of violation of departmental merit/seniority laid down by the selection committee. This will be done by pulling the junior down immediately below his senior in merit.

NOTE: In cases where a junior in the combined & seniority list is being considered for assessment, all persons senior to him/her in the seniority list will also be considered even though the seniors do not have the requisite years of service. The senior if found fit will be given notional promotion with effect from the date of promotion of his/her junior and for purpose of pay etc., it would be granted to him/her with effect from the date of actual promotion i.e. the date on which he completes 3 years service on the grade at the AIIMS, provided the following two conditions are fulfilled:-

- a) Probation should have been completed by him/her successfully.
- b) The total period of extension granted to join the service should not have exceeded 6 months.

7. ASSESSMENT PROCESS


The Assessment Board shall take into consideration its recommendations of the Head of the Department/Unit, the performance of the faculty members with reference to annual confidential reports and his/her performance in the interview for deciding his fitness for promotion to the next higher grade. However, the Board may consider in absentia the candidature of such faculty members as are unable to present themselves for interview.

8. NUMBER OF CHANCES

Faculty members would be eligible to avail of three consecutive chances to appear before the Standing Selection Committee in 3 (three) years.

Out of 102, 02 candidates, namely Dr. Asmita Patil (Sl. No.59) to the grade of Professor of Physiology for the batch of 01-07-2022 and Dr. Maroof Ahmad Khan (Sl. No. 73) to the grade of Professor of Biostatistics for the batch of 01-07-2022, were found unfit by the Standing Selection Committee.

The remarks of the Standing selection Committee in these cases are as below.

Dr. Asmita Patil (Sl. No. 59) :-

Dr. Asmita Patil was interviewed for promotion to the post of Professor of Physiology with the assistance of two external experts, Dr. Mrunal Phatak, Professor & Head, Department of Physiology, AIIMS, Nagpur and Dr. A.K. Pandey, Professor & Head, Department of Physiology, ESIC Medical College, NIT-3, Faridabad – 121 001. The interview continued for almost 40 minutes. Her research output in terms of publications and number of grants during the assessment period were unsatisfactory. For example, publication (Pub-Med.) within the assessment period as the first or corresponding author were only Two; and extramural grant as PI was nil. She could not satisfactorily answer the questions posed by the experts. The Selection Committee along with the experts unanimously decided to declare her "UNFIT" for promotion to the post of Professor of Physiology.

Dr. Maroof Ahmad Khan (Sl. No. 73):-

Dr. Mafoof Ahmad Khan was interviewed for promotion to the post of Professor of Biostatistics with the assistance of two external experts, Dr. S.K. Upadhyaya, Professor, Department of Statistics, Institute of Science, Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi – 221 005 and Dr. K. Thennarasu, Professor & Head, Department of Biostatistics, NIMHANS, Bangalore. The interview continued for almost 40 minutes. His research output in terms of publications and number of grants during the assessment period were unsatisfactory. For example, publication within the assessment period as the first or corresponding author were only two; and extramural grant as PI was only One. He could not satisfactorily answer the questions posed by the experts. The Selection Committee along with the experts unanimously decided to declare him "UNFIT" for promotion to the post of Professor of Biostatistics.

The committee noted that the recommendations of the Standing Selection Committee in respect of Dr. Anoop Kumar Daga for promotion to the grade of Additional Professor was kept in a sealed cover as disciplinary proceedings under Rule 14 of the CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 is pending against him. The HR Sub Committee therefore recommended that recommendations of the Standing Selection Committee may only be taken into consideration after conclusion of said disciplinary proceedings and outcome of the same, as per laid down instructions on the subject.

After due deliberations, the HR Sub-Committee approved the recommendations of the Standing Selection Committee for 230 posts of Assistant Professors in 91 disciplines and promotion of eligible Assistant, Associate and Additional Professors to Associate Prof., Additional Prof. & Professor respectively under APS scheme.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
