ITEM NO. SFC - 215/1

CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF 214^{TH} MEETING OF THE STANDING FINANCE COMMITTEE OF AIIMS HELD ON 10^{TH} DECEMBER, 2016 IN MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE, NIRMAN BHAWAN, NEW DELHI

The SFC confirmed the minutes of the meeting and no amendments were proposed by any of the members. Health Secretary further advised that the role of the SFC is to consider cases where financial sanctions are required, and the SFC meetings should not be used as review meetings.



ITEM NO. SFC - 215/2

ACTION TAKEN ON THE MINUTES OF 212TH & 213TH MEETING OF THE STANDING FINANCE COMMITTEE OF AIIMS HELD ON 26.07.2016 & 14.09.2016 IN MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE, NIRMAN BHAWAN, NEW DELHI

The SFC noted the status of compliance of the decisions of the 212th and 213th meetings dated 26/7/2016 and 14/9/2016. The Additional Secretary and Financial Advisor MOHFW said that proposals for creation of posts may be submitted to Government in accordance with the EMC guidelines along with the current status of the vacant posts available in the Institute. She said that several proposals for creation of posts like the National Cancer Institute at Jhajjar are being returned from Ministry of Finance with these observations. The Chairman said that the EFC memorandum for the Expansion of Trauma Center may be expedited as comments from all concerned ministries and NITI Aayog have been received. The Chairman further said that AIIMS may review the financial sanctions and available resources in civil works projects. A meeting in this regard shall be convened at the level of Director AIIMS before new projects are sanctioned.

ITEM NO. SFC - 215/3

PROPOSAL FOR CENTRE OF ADVANCED RESEARCH AND EXCELLENCE ON CHILDHOOD NEURO-DEVELOPMENTAL DISORDERS IN CHILD NEUROLOGY DIVISION DEPARTMENT OF PEDIATRICS

The Chairman sought a clarification from Director AIIMS on the procedure adopted for establishment of the Centers of Excellence. Director AIIMS appraised the SFC that the proposals for establishment centers of excellence are not placed for consideration of the Staff Council or the Academic Committee but are brought to the SFC with concurrence of the concerned Head of Department, the Finance Division and the Director AIIMS. Accordingly the proposals for (a) the Centre of Excellence for Neurodevelopmental Disorders (agenda item SFC 215/3) (b) the Centre for Infectious Diseases (agenda item SFC 215/4) and (c) the Centre for Integrative Medicine and Research (SFC- 215/17) are being submitted for consideration of the SFC. The SFC heard the presentation made by Prof Sheffali Gulati, Division Head Child Neurology Division and supplemented by Prof V.K.Paul, HOD Pediatrics. Following discussions, the SFC decided that the AIIMS may submit the proposal on file with (a) clarity in the agenda item; (b) certificate that it is critical and essential; (c) availability of space; (d) manpower needs and (e) the certificate by Finance division of AIIMS on resource availability.

ITEM NO. SFC - 215/4 TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL FOR THE ESTABLISHING THE INFECTIOUS DISEASES FACILITY AT AIIMS

The SFC was appraised that the Governing Body in its 154th meeting had approved the establishment of the Center for Infectious Diseases on the top 4 floors of National Center for Ageing. The SFC said that the detailed proposal with manpower requirements and machinery & equipment requirements will be brought for consideration.

MACHINARY & EQUIPMENT PLAN FOR NCI JHAJJAR

The SFC took the view that the CCEA has approved the machinery and equipment procurement as part of the Cabinet note and AIIMS may commence procurement in pursuance of the Cabinet decision. The payments issues may be resolved by AIIMS and HITES. The proposal for constitution of an empowered committee for procurement with delegation of financial powers through amendments in AIIMS regulations may be pursued separately.
