Professor of Dental Public Health at Barts & The London School of Medicine and Dentistry, Queen Mary University of London, Honorary Consultant Academic at Public Health

England. Research in the prevention of childhood dental caries; expertise in randomised controlled trials; multidisciplinary collaborations. Over 100 scientific publications; national and international research grants: Director of a WHO Collaborating Centre for ten years. Invited to present her research in 26 countries and universities globally; a Visiting Fellow to the National Institutes of Health in the USA. Founding President of the European Association of Dental Public Health, elected first Honorary Member "for her outstanding contribution to promoting teaching and

research in dental public health across Europe". In 2015, awarded ORCA Prize "in recognition of outstanding contributions to the field of dental caries research". Appointed CBE by the Queen in 2006, For Services to Dentistry.

Professor of Nutrition and Oral Health, Centre for Oral Health Research and the Institute of Health & Society, Newcastle University. Director, Centre for Oral Health Research, Newcastle University. Director for World Health Organization Collaborating Centre for Nutrition & Oral Health for fourteen years. Recipient of the 2010 International Association for Dental Research Distinguished Scientist and Award for 'Geriatric Oral Research'. Awarded The Nutrition Society Silver Medal for 'Excellence in Research by a Young Scientist' in 2004. Invited by WHO to serve as Expert Advisor on dietary sugars to their Nutrition Guideline Advisory Group (NUGAG).
