Eligibility Criteria

- The NBRCOM-2024 is open to all biomedical researchers (UG, PG, PhD, resident doctors, JRF, SRF, postdocs, scientists, and faculties).
- To be eligible for the Young Research Award, age of the presenters/researchers should be less than 35 years as on 01-12-2024.
- However, researchers over the age of 35 years can present their research at NBRCOM-2024 for Best Presentation Awards in 6-10th
- Researchers/Students who are working under the members (faculty/scientists/doctors etc) of the organizing committee are not eligible for any prizes and awards. However, they are allowed to participate and present their research work at NBRCOM 2024.
- Researchers/Students who are working under the jury members are not eligible for prizes and awards in the same category where the jury member is judging. However, if their presentation is in a different category, then they will be eligible for prizes and awards.
- In case of Jury members, if there is any type of 'conflict of interest' with respect to judging the presentation, they will inform the organising committee before proceeding to judge the presentations.
- Young researcher awardees (1st, 2nd & 3rd prize winners) in NBRCOM-2018, -2019, -2021, and (1st to 5th prize winners) in NBRCOM-2023 can present their research work at NBRCOM 2024, but they will not be eligible for prizes and Young Researcher Award in the NBRCOM-24.
- The event will be held in a hybrid mode, offering both virtual (01 Dec.) and offline (02-03 Dec.) options. The virtual mode is available primarily for researchers working outside of India, although a few presentations from researchers at Indian universities or institutes may be considered based on genuine reasons.

🕨 Evaluation Criteria 🛚

The research competition will be conducted on 01-03 December 2024. Each speaker will present one's research work for up to 7 minutes, and 2 minutes will remain reserved for addressing questions and/or concerns from the jury and audiences. The evaluation criteria for prizes and awards are as follows: 75% of the marks are based on novelty, knowledge, and presentation, which will be awarded by jury members. The remaining 25% of the marks are based on plagiarism and the review report. Reviews and case reports will not be considered for presentation at NBRCOM 2024. The names of the winners along with their ranks in each category will be announced during the closing ceremony of the competition. The judges' decision will be the final and no further clarification whatsoever will be issued. All registered presenters and participating delegates will receive a presentation and participation certificate.
