

Protocol for Patient Receiving at ICU



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PREPARATION

- Patient receiving checklist cleared.
- Patient allowed to enter the ICU.
- One person at head end and two other person by the side of bed while shifting.
- One person for attaching monitors and any drugs, if required.



EXTUBATED PATIENTS



- ❑ Receive extubated patients on nasal prongs with N95 facemask.
- ❑ Switch off the oxygen source at shifting trolley before disconnecting the prong.
- ❑ Clamp the tubing of prong temporarily.
- ❑ Disconnect it from shifting oxygen source.
- ❑ Attach with ICU source of oxygen.
- ❑ Remove the clamp.
- ❑ Start oxygenation

INTUBATED PATIENTS

- ❑ Receive a well sedated / paralyzed patients.
- ❑ Check for cuff inflation and viral filter.
- ❑ Follow the protocol for transferring patients to ventilator.
- ❑ Start ventilation.



How to Transfer a Patient On Ventilator?

- ❑ Ensure patient is well sedated/ paralyzed.
- ❑ Recheck quickly the ventilator settings.
- ❑ Switch off the oxygen flow to the transport ventilator/ Bain's circuit.
- ❑ Turn down the Transport ventilator.
- ❑ Always clamp the ETT.
- ❑ Disconnect the ETT with viral filter from transport circuit.
- ❑ Connect ETT with filter with the ventilator.
- ❑ Unclamp ETT and start Ventilation.
- ❑ Confirm with etCO₂.
- ❑ Start sedation
