Protocol for Patient Receiving at ICU



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PREPARATION

- Patient receiving checklist cleared.
- Patient allowed to enter the ICU.
- One person at head end and two other person by the side of bed while shifting.
- One person for attaching monitors and any drugs, if required.



EXTUBATED PATIENTS



- Receive extubated patients on nasal prongs with N95 facemask.
- Switch off the oxygen source at shifting trolley before disconnecting the prong.
- Clamp the tubing of prong temporarily.
- Disconnect it from shifting oxygen source.
- Attach with ICU source of oxygen.
- Remove the clamp.
- Start oxygenation

INTUBATED PATIENTS

- Receive a well sedated / paralyzed patients.
- Check for cuff inflation and viral filter.
- Follow the protocol for transferring patients to ventilator.
- Start ventilation.



How to Transfer a Patient On Ventilator?

- Ensure patient is well sedated/ paralyzed.
- Recheck quickly the ventilator settings.
- Switch off the oxygen flow to the transport ventilator/ Bain's circuit.
- Turn down the Transport ventilator.
- Always clamp the ETT.
- Disconnect the ETT with viral filter from transport circuit.
- Connect ETT with filter with the ventilator.
- Unclamp ETT and start Ventilation.
- Confirm with etCO2.
- Start sedation
