
1. Personal Interview for the participants from Delhi / Skype interview for the outstation participants selected applications will be held for the Post.
2. Age relaxation is admissible in respect of SC/ST/OBC candidates as per Government of India Rules, **in respect of the posts reserved for those categories.**
3. Clear proof of Qualifications, Experience, Caste / Community should be attached. Applications without these required attachments shall be rejected.
4. Date / time of personal interview / Skype/video call interview will be intimated through email for Eligible/ Shortlisted candidates only.
5. Candidate should submit all copies of certificates / testimonials.
6. Experience certificate should clearly state the nature of work during the period of employment.

7. Community/ Caste certificate: Candidates applying under OBC category, shall submit attested copy of OBC Non – Creamy Layer Certificate in specified format, issued within one year from the closing date of application by the appropriate authority. Only Non -Creamy Layer OBC certificates will be accepted, and other certificates will not be accepted.
8. No- Objection Certificate from the current employer (for Govt./AB/PSU Servants only).
