Technical Specification

- 1. Company should have USFDA certificate / CE certificates with 4 digit notifying body, identification number of international standards / BIS certification.
- 2. Company name and catalogue / article number engraved on each instrument.
- 3. Each instrument should have data matrix/bar code which should be scannable and verifiable to establish origin and make of the instrument.
- 4. Instruments should be corrosion free and manufactured from high surgical grade stainless stee (Stainless steel alloy of 400-450 grade).
