- 1. Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibilit regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to t maximum of quoted GST %.
- 2. Experience Criteria: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufa and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for 2 years bef bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied so quantity during each of the year. In case of bunch bids, the primary product having highest value should mee criterion.
- 3. **Manufacturer Authorization:** Wherever Authorised Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorisation Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid
- 4. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 50 of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ord quantity up to 50% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clau exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of exter delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity ÷ Original quantity) × Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time shall be original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.
- 5. While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screensh portal confirming payment of GST.
