Subject: Section 15(6) of Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997 – Mandatory compliance of the Delhi Medical Council Act by all the Resident Doctors regarding

In pursuance of Section 15(6) of the Delhi Medical Council Act, 1997, it is notified that “Any person servicing or practising modern scientific system of medicine in NCT of Delhi shall be registered with the Delhi Medical Council. Without registration with the Council any person though qualified in modern scientific system of medicine shall be liable for action as specified by the Council”.

Accordingly, all the Resident Doctors are hereby advised to register themselves under Section 15(6) of Delhi Medical Council, 1997 with immediate effect to continue their residency in the Institute.
